U.S. APPEAL

BOMBER **FLIGHTS**

WASHINGTON, April 27.

The US asked the UN Security Council yesterday to consider international control of bomber flights over the Arctic. The Council will meet on Tuesday to discuss the question.

The US move follows last week's drama in the Security Council when Russia abruptly withdrew a resolution demanding an immediate end to flights of US nuclear bombers towards the Soviet frontiers.

Meanwhile, messages from Moscow say that Russia has stipulated that Poland and Czechoslovakia should have seats at joint pre-summit diplomatic talks.
